

SUNY IS THE WAY TO ECONOMIC RECOVERY

SUNY CAMPUSES, THE LIFELINE OF OUR LOCAL COMMUNITIES, NEED YOUR SUPPORT



Fifteen SUNY campuses, along with two SUNY hospitals, are located in 13 counties with poverty rates exceeding the state's overall poverty rate. An investment in SUNY is a direct and necessary investment in our communities.



TO PROPERLY FUND THE SUNY SYSTEM, WE REQUEST THAT THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATURE PROVIDE:

- » \$200 million in new operating funds to the four-year SUNY campuses, as proposed in the Assembly's one-house budget proposal.
- » At least \$88 million for hiring new faculty, an area identified by the Senate and Assembly one-house budget proposal.
- » \$68 million for debt service relief as proposed by the Senate (SUNY's hospitals are the only state entities pay their own debt service) and \$143 million in critical mission funding for hospital operations, as proposed by the Assembly.
